1. Where will the redevelopment water be discharged for the project?
Is there an existing NPDES permit covering the discharge?

The SLVWD does have a NPDES discharge permit. The contractor will be working with District representatives regarding discharges and discharge locations while onsite. The Oly 3 site has a discharge location that most likely will not reach receiving waters. The Quail 5a site has a drainage culvert that redevelopment water can be discharged to.
