The Lompico Community needs your help!

Prior to the San Lorenzo Valley Water District (SLVWD) officially assuming responsibility for the public water system in Lompico Canyon, an Assessment District (AD 2016-1) was formed to help pay for replacement of outdated water facilities. As a property owner or renter in Lompico Canyon, you are a member of AD 2016-1.

Your water district (SLVWD) created a committee to assist in oversight of AD 2016-1 for the benefit of the Lompico community. The Lompico Assessment District Oversight Committee (LADOC) consists of five residents living within the boundaries of AD 2016-1.

There are currently three vacancies on LADOC, and SLVWD is encouraging interested residents to volunteer some time for the benefit of your community. LADOC currently meets quarterly to review expenditures related to AD 2016-1. The time commitment is typically a few hours every three months. This is a great opportunity to stay informed regarding improvements to your water system. Additionally, as a member of LADOC you will be a liaison to the Lompico community and the entire community of SLVWD customers.
